- Participants will not be eligible to compete if full payment does not reach the
 Thailand Aquatics by the specified deadline.
- It is mandatory for participants' entries to include a passport number (for foreigners) and all required information. Incomplete or erroneous entries will be rejected.

H. JUDGES

Judge assignments are managed by the organizing committee. Each team must send a minimum of one and a maximum of two judges to participate (expenses should be covered by each NF team). If a team fails to send judges, the organizing committee will arrange for judges them and charge 500 USD.

SWIMMING

1. RULES & REGULATIONS

This Championships shall be conducted under the Rules and By-laws of World Aquatics as prescribed in the World Aquatics Handbook 2023-2025. One-start rule applies.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Swimmers must be registered members of their respective National Swimming Federations / Associations of the Southeast Asian Countries.

3. SWIM WEAR - 2022

The entire list took effect on January 1, 2022, and is good through the end of this year.



11. EVENT CANCELLATION

A. Individual Events: There shall be a maximum of 3 entries/per country.

- B. For event with 3 entries, the event will proceed with a minus one rule for the award of medals.
- C. The events shall be cancelled if entries received on the closing date are below the minimum number.
- D. Participating teams that are affected by the cancellation shall be informed and given 3 days to resubmit alternate entries,

12. WITHDRAWALS

- A. Withdrawals may be done during the Team Managers' Meeting.
- B. An administrative fee of 15 USD shall be imposed for each withdrawal after the Team Managers' Meeting. The swimmer is allowed to swim in subsequent race after payment of the fine.
- C. Team Managers must present withdrawals to the Championship Referee no less than one (1) hour prior to the start of the championship start time of the day.
- D. A penalty fee of 30 USD shall be imposed for no shows.
- E. The administrative fee and penalty fee shall be waived if the swimmer produces a valid medical certificate for the relevant day of the race. Otherwise, the swimmer shall not be permitted to compete in any race.

13. PROTESTS

- A. Protests are possible:
 - If the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed.
 - If conditions endanger the competition and/or competitors.
 - Against decisions of the referee, however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.
 - All protests shall be considered by the Championship Referee.

If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the competition, a protest must be lodged verbally before the signal to start the race is given. This is to be followed immediately with a written protest.

- B. Protests must be submitted in accordance with the following:
 - In writing, with the supporting facts.

- With a deposit of 200 USD enclosed.
- Submitted to the Championships Referee by the Team Manager (only).
- Submitted within thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the event concerned.

If the Championships Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his/her decision. The Team Manager may then appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal whose decision shall be final.

If the protest is rejected, the deposit shall be forfeited to the Organizing Committee of the Championships. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.

JURY OF APPEALS

- A. One (1) Chairman (host country).
- B. Each country is to nominate a team official in their team list as the Jury of Appeal.
- C. Three (3) members to be appointed from members of SEA countries.

14. COMPETITION FORMAT

All events will be timed finals in the respective age-groups and competitors shall be placed in graduated time order, from the slowest to fastest.

15. TEAM LIST

Participating teams shall submit their entries using the official entry forms provided.

These forms include:

- A. Team list of swimmers with their dates of birth.
- B. The names of accompanying officials and their designations.
- C. In-coming and out-going flight schedules.
- D. Reservation for board and accommodation.

16. AWARDS

Championship Award shall be presented to the Overall winner. The Champion Team shall be determined based on the following (regardless of Age Group):

- A. The total amount of Gold Medals.
- B. If there is a tie for Gold, the total amount of Silver Medals.
- C. If there is a tie for Silver, the total amount of Bronze Medals.
- D. If there is a tie for Bronze, the total number of records broken.

INDIVIDUAL / TEAM AWARDS

- A. Gold Medal for First Place.
- B. Silver Medal for Second Place.
- C. Bronze Medal for Third Place.

For event with 3 entries per country, a minus one rule shall apply for the award of medals.

CERTIFICATES


- A. Certificate of Recognition will be awarded to all new record holders.
- B. Certificate of Participation will be given to all participants.

Support and Responsibilities for Swimming International Technical Officials (SW ITOs)

- 1. Nomination and Approval:
 - Each National Federation (NF) may nominate up to two Swimming International
 Technical Officials (SW ITOs). They must be on the current WA Swimming Official List #21
 and #22
 - o All nominations are subject to approval by SEA Aquatics.
- 2. Support Provided by the Organizing Committee (OC):
 - o For the First SW ITO:
 - The Organizing Committee will cover hotel accommodations, meals, and provide a per diem.
- 3. Responsibilities of National Federations:
 - o Airfare:
 - Each NF is responsible for covering the airfare for up to two SW ITOs.
 - o For the Second SW ITO:
 - Each NF will also be responsible for the hotel accommodations and meals for the second SW ITO.

17. WARM-UP GUIDELINES

The Competition and Warm-Up Pools will be available for warm-ups one and the half hour before the competitions commences. The competition pool will be closed fifteen (15) minutes before the beginning of each session.



Lane assignments for warm-ups will be in accordance with World Aquatics Swimming Rules

WARM-UP POOL

- A. The Warm-Up Pool will be CIRCLE SWIMMING ONLY, with feet first entry from sitting position at all times.
- B. The use of swim paddles, fins/flippers are prohibited during warm-up COMPETITION POOL
 - A. The schematic in the diagram shall be always observed during warm-ups.
 - B. There shall be NO DIVING in the Circle Swimming Lanes, the Turn Practice Lanes, and the 50m Pace Lane (opposite side). Entry to these lanes is always via feet first entry from the sitting position.
 - C. The use of swim paddles and fins/flippers are prohibited during warm-up.

- D. The Dive Sprint Lanes are one-way only swimmers should clear the lanes immediately and walk back. Swimmers are advised to exercise caution when doing Backstroke starts.
- E. Coaches and Team Officials will be allowed on the Competition Pool Deck during the warm-up sessions.
- F. To ensure a smooth swimming competition Time-Lines compliance, eliminate unnecessary downtime due to infraction enquiry to the referee, promote fair play during the swimming competition and eliminate Technical Officials duty obstruction, the pool deck is strictly out of bound to all except the Technical Officials on duty, Swimming Competition Management Committee, Appointed Volunteer, Appointed Media Cover

DIVING

1. RULES & REGULATIONS

The Championships shall be conducted under the rules and by-laws of World Aquatics as prescribed in the World Aquatics Competition Regulation: Diving Rules 2024.

7. LIMIT ENTRY

Each country may register maximum 2 divers per individual event.

Host country may register maximum 3 divers per individual event.

Each country may register up to 1 pair per synchronized event

8. ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for Diving is 50 USD per athlete (inclusive of farewell dinner)

9. WITHDRAWALS

- A. Team Managers must present withdrawals to the Technical Delegate no less than one (1) hour prior to the start of the championship start time of the day.
- B. A penalty fee of 30 USD shall be imposed for no shows.
- C. The penalty fee shall be waived if the diver produces a valid medical certificate for the relevant day of the race. Otherwise, the diver shall not be permitted to compete in any events for the whole day.

10. PROTESTS

A. Protests are possible:

- a. If the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed.
- b. If conditions endanger the competition and/or competitors.
- c. Against decisions of the referee, however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.
- d. All protests shall be considered by the Championship Referee.
- e. If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the competition, a protest must be lodged verbally before the signal to start the race is given. This is to be followed immediately with a written protest
- B. Protests must be submitted in accordance with the following:
 - a. In writing, with the supporting facts.
 - b. With a deposit of 200 USD enclosed.
 - c. Submitted to the Championships Referee by the Team Manager (only).
 - d. Submitted within thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the event concerned.

- i. If the Championships Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his/her decision. The Team Manager may then appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal whose decision shall be final.
- ii. If the protest is rejected, the deposit shall be forfeited to the Organizing Committee of the Championships. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.

JURY OF APPEALS

- A. One (1) Chairman (host country).
- B. Each country is to nominate a team official in their team list as the Jury of Appeal.
- C. Three (3) members to be appointed from members of SEA countries.

11. AWARDS

The first 3 (three) positions will be awarded for each event. If the top 3 (three) divers come from 1 country, the bronze medal will be given to the diver from another country.

12. JUDGES

Support and Responsibilities for Accompanying Diving Judges (DV ITOs)

1. Nomination and Approval:

Each National Federation (NF) may nominate up to two Diving Judges; Priority of Judges will be selected as follows:

- Currently A or G judges who are on the current World Aquatics List, must have successfully passed the judges exam administered at a World Aquatics Diving Certification School with non-expired certification.
- All nominations are subject to approval by SEA Aquatics.
- 2. Responsibilities of National Federations for:

Each NF is responsible for covering the airfare, hotel and meals for up to two accompanying DV ITOs

 Neutral Judges: SEAA will appoint neutral judges to ensure a balance between the judges' nationalities.

Work assignments are managed by the organizing committee. Each team must send a minimum of one and a maximum of two judges to participate (expenses should be covered by each NF team). If a team fails to send judges, the organizing committee will arrange for them and charge 500 USD. (Only Applicable for Diving)

WATER POLO

1. RULES & REGULATIONS

The Championships shall be conducted under the Rules and By-laws of World Aquatics as prescribed in the World Aquatics Competition Regulations 2024: Water Polo.

FIELD OF PLAY

The size of the field shall be $30 \, \mathrm{m} \times 20 \, \mathrm{m}$ for Men's competition, and $25 \, \mathrm{m} \times 20 \, \mathrm{m}$ for Women's competition.

TEAMS AND SUBSTITUTES

- Each Federation/ Association will enter, maximum of 2 Team for Men consisting of 13 players, 1 head coach, 1 coach, 1 referee and 1 manager, and 1 Physician.
- Each Federation/ Association will enter, maximum of 2 Team for Women only consisting of 13 players, 1 head coach, 1 coach, 1 referee and 1 manager, and 1 Physician.
- Each team shall appoint 13 players for each game out of the listed 13 player roster and shall notify the Organizing Committee of the team's roster for each game prior to the designated deadline.

DURATION OF THE GAME

- The duration of the game shall be 4 periods of 8 minutes each of actual play. Time shall commence at the start of each period when a player touches the ball. At all signals for stoppages, the recording watch shall be stopped until the ball is put back into play by the ball leaving the hand of the player taking the appropriate throw or when the ball is touched by a player following a neutral throw.
- There shall be 2 minutes interval between the 1^{st} / 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} / 4^{th} periods and 3 minutes interval at half time. The teams shall change ends at half time.
- Every game that is drawn at the end of the 4 periods of play will be decided by conducting a penalty shoot-out.

- Each Federation/ Association will enter with minimum 1, maximum 2 Team for Women. only consisting of 13 players and 5 officials.

COMPETITION

- In the case of not more than 6-7 teams participating, the competition will be played on a round robin basis in one group.
- In the case of 7-8 or 12 teams participating, the competition will be played in preliminary round by two divided groups on round robin basis in each group, followed by cross-over final rounds.
- In case of 13 or more teams participating, the preliminary round will be played in groups a round robin basis in each group, followed by cross-over final rounds. Detailed schedule will be drawn up at the Managers Meeting.

BALL

The ball used in the competitions shall be Men's ball for Men's competition, and Women's Ball for Women's competition in accordance with World Aquatics Rules & Regulations.

8. WITHDRAWALS

Every participating NF must nominate the Technical Controllers to the SEAAG. Priority of Technical Controller will be selected as follows

- Technical Controllers who are on the current World Aquatics Technical Controllers List
- National Technical Controllers who attend, must have passed the Technical Controller course conducted by World Aquatics

National Federations must apply to the SEAF, for the registrations and approval of their judge(s) and Technical Controllers by 30 Oct 2024. If a Federation wishes to nominate more than two judges and /or Technical Controller, they must announce the first 2 judges / Technical Controllers. Additional judges/Technical Controllers will only be accepted if there are enough vacancies. The final selection of the judges and Technical Controllers will be by the Technical Delegate and SEAF.

- Each participating federation is responsible for the international travel, accommodation, and the meal expenses of the selected judges and Technical Controllers.
- SEAA will appoint neutral judges and neutral Technical Controllers to ensure a balance between the judges' nationalities.
